ACADEMIC SUPPORTS

120 students across all 4 SPPN Pathway Schools completed the Sankofa reading program, run by SPPN partner NdCAD, during the 2016-2017 school year



» 96% of children who completed the Sankofa reading program run by SPPN Partner, NdCAD, improved 1-7 reading levels in 9 weeks

771 Promise Neighborhood students prevented the summer learning loss by attending an SPPN partner program this past summer

» Over the past 5 summers, 96% of students in SPPN summer programs maintained or improved their literacy scores



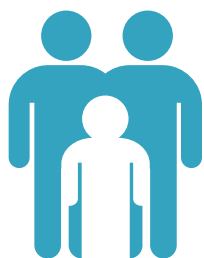
400+ aligned resources to increase access to high-quality early learning programs and improve school readiness for three- and four-year-old children in the Promise Neighborhood

14,000+ engagement efforts were made by SPPN navigators to engage parents in the educational process of their children
