Mission

Wilder is a collective force for social good that works to see all people thrive. We champion stability and wellness through direct services, advocacy, and research.

Communities Served

Nearly all (99%) of families served are below 200% of the federal poverty level, with 28% at or below 100% of the federal poverty level. When we look at who Wilder serves more closely, we see a reflection of the neighborhoods in Saint Paul where our programs operate. Over 80% of participants are people of color from the Black/African American and the Southeast Asian communities, including Hmong, Karen, Cambodian and Vietnamese.

We also are seeing more folks from the Hispanic/Latinx communities, as well as the newly arriving Afghan community. We serve folks who are facing multiple challenges to their overall family stability – whether that's navigating immigration, experiencing poverty, seeking stable housing, securing transportation, speaking a primary language other than English, or living with a mental or physical disability.

Areas Served

Wilder's direct services primarily serve the east metropolitan region of Ramsey, Dakota, and Anoka counties, with a particular focus on St. Paul neighborhoods including Frogtown, Hamline-Midway, Thomas-Dale, Payne-Phalen, North End, and Dayton's Bluff. Our advocacy efforts address issues across Minnesota, while our research services extend both statewide and nationally.
